Nye County School District (NCSD) and Great Basin College (GBC) welcomes high school students enrolling in "dual credit" college courses for high school and college credit. Students may choose to take classes at a GBC campus, or electronically through interactive video or by personal computer online. High school students must meet the admission requirements as stated in GBC's current college catalog. Depending on student interest and the dual credit course schedule, juniors may enroll for 3 to 6 college credits within a school year and seniors may enroll in 3 to 15 college credit courses.

Students and their parents, or funds from Dollars for Scholars pay college tuition and the technology lab fee, costing approximately \$200 for each 3 credit hour course. Even though supportive of the dual credit program, many parents in our communities cannot afford this cost.

ADOPT a STUDENT Community Scholarship Program is set up to assist these parents and their children. Community donors may elect to support one or more dual credit courses by contributing to the Adopt a Student fund account held by the NyE Communities Coalition. The Adopt a Student funds will be utilized once the Dollars for Scholars funding is depleted. This Community Scholarship Program is a community funded supplement to the Dollars for Scholars Program.
